## **Position Summary:**

The Director, Office of Institutional Assessment, supports the University's comprehensive institutional assessment efforts through the collection, analysis and distribution of meaningful data. Reporting to the Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs, Academic Resources, the position will work with divisions and departments in providing support and guidance in the development of the accreditation reports and annual assessment reports.

### **Responsibilities:**

- o Data collection, analysis and interpretation
- o Lead in the creation and execution of an institution-wide student learning assessment plan
- Work with both administrative and academic departments and divisions to develop institutional effectiveness goals, outcomes, assessment, and plan and execute improvement initiatives
- Assist in responding to state, federal and other externally mandated reporting requirements, and to accrediting agencies
- o Provide annual reports on university-wide teaching and learning assessment results for use by the University administration and faculty
- o Administer and interpret institution-wide assessment instruments such as the NSSE
- Track national and state best practices in assessment and inform collaborative partners regarding information

## **Qualifications:**

Minimum qualifications are a Master's degree in higher education, social sciences, statistics or related fields. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills; strong qualitative and quantitative research skills. Assessment and evaluation experience, including the challenges in fostering an institution-wide culture and commitment to assessment, at a comparable university. *Preferred:* Earned doctorate in related fields; SACSCOC experience.
