## ACADEMIC VACANCY

**POSITION:** **Tenure-Track Assistant Professor-Industrial Design EEO # AR 6-14**

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** The School of Architecture and Design seeks a full-time tenure-track Assistant Professor with commitment to undergraduate education and expertise in Industrial Design for a growing B.I.D. Program with 78 majors. Candidate should have excellent pedagogy in industrial design and a strong background in design through education and professional practice. The candidate will need to have expertise in design studio, materials and processes including 3D modeling (Rhino), CNC technology integration into curriculum, and rapid prototyping technologies (such as Dimension 3D printer). Peer-reviewed recognition of teaching, research, and/or design works desirable. The successful candidate will be expected to engage in creative research, scholarship and in the governance of the Program, School and University and include duties such as managing the program's website. The candidate shall demonstrate a strong commitment to take a leadership role in integrating teaching technologies. Emphasis will be placed on the candidate's ability to collaborate with students and colleagues on issues related to program development and accreditation.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** MFA, MID, or Ph.D. in Industrial Design or terminal degree in a related field required. IDSA affiliation desired.

**ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:** The College of the Arts includes the School of Architecture and Design, School of Music and Performing Arts, and the Department of Visual Arts. The School of Architecture and Design has a full-time faculty of 18 and serves three majors in architecture, industrial design, and interior design. The Industrial Design Program has three full-time faculty, who in conjunction with other faculty in the School, serve the accredited B.I.D. degree program. Several labs include a wood shop, metal shop, rapid prototyping shop, and the Digital Media Resource Center.

Founded in 1898, the University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a public research university with high research activity. The university is the largest member of the University of Louisiana System that consists of nine institutions. The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges accredits the university.

The university offers degree programs in 54 undergraduate disciplines, 20 post bachelor certificates, three graduate certificates, the master's degree in 28 disciplines, and the doctorate in 10 disciplines. UL Lafayette has an enrollment of 18,000 students with a full-time faculty of 600. UL Lafayette consists of nine degree-granting units—Arts, B.I. Moody III College of Business Administration, Education, Engineering, University College, Graduate School, Liberal Arts, Nursing and Allied Health Professions, and the Ray P. Authement College of Sciences.
