POSITION: **Tenure-Track Assistant Professor-Architecture** EEO # AR 7-14

RESPONSIBILITIES: The School of Architecture and Design seeks a full-time tenure-track Assistant Professor with a commitment to undergraduate and graduate education with expertise in architectural pedagogy, basic design, and a strong background in design through education and professional practice for a program with 201 majors. The candidate will need to have expertise in teaching basic design and architecture design studios, graphic communications (including sketching, Adobe Suite, and 3D modeling), CNC technology integration into curriculum, HABS, and related courses. Responsibilities are teaching foundation courses as well as online courses. Peer-reviewed recognition of teaching, research and/or design works desirable. The successful candidate will be expected to engage in research and scholarship, integrating teaching technologies including the development of web-based coursework and engage in the governance of the Program, School and University. Emphasis will be placed on the candidate's ability to collaborate with students and colleagues on issues related to the program's development and accreditation.

QUALIFICATIONS: M.Arch, D.Arch, or Ph.D. in Architecture, or a terminal degree in related field required. Completion of internship is required with architectural license desired.

ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT: The College of the Arts includes the School of Architecture and Design, School of Music and Performing Arts and the Department of Visual Arts. The School of Architecture and Design has a full-time faculty of 18 and serves three majors in architecture, interior design and industrial design. The Architecture program has twelve full-time faculty who in conjunction with other faculty in the School serve the accredited degree program. Several labs include a wood shop, a rapid prototyping shop and the Digital Media Resource Center.

Founded in 1898, the University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a public research university with high research activity. The university is the largest member of the University of Louisiana System that consists of nine institutions. The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges accredits the university.

The university offers degree programs in 54 undergraduate disciplines, 20 post bachelor certificates, three graduate certificates, the master's degree in 28 disciplines, and the doctorate in 10 disciplines. UL Lafayette has an enrollment of 18,000 students with a full-time faculty of 600. UL Lafayette consists of nine degree-granting units—Arts, B.I. Moody III College of Business Administration, Education, Engineering, University College, Graduate School, Liberal Arts, Nursing and Allied Health Professions, and the Ray P. Authement College of Sciences.
