Additional duties include: advising students in the College of Education;

supervising student teachers; developing and implementing projects associated with the applicant's research agenda; serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees; engaging in scholarly activities and other professional activities as deemed necessary by the department, college or university.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must have earned a terminal degree in Curriculum & Instruction, or a

related field. Candidates must have at least three years of classroom experience as a certified teacher. Experience teaching at the college level is desirable. In addition, the applicant should have or show potential to produce scholarly publications, grants, and participation in premiere professional organizations. Candidates who are ABD will be considered, **but degree must be completed prior to starting date**. Preference will be given to applicant's who: 1) demonstrate a

robust ability to intersect the social studies with other disciplines; 2) have led or contributed to NCATE/CAEP, NCSS, or ACEI accreditation reports; or 3) have

designed or taught courses through hybrid or online delivery.
