RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Office of Operational Review is seeking applicants for the position of Associate Director of Operational Review. The position reports to the Director of Operational Review. The Associate Director will work closely with University administrators, faculty and employees throughout the University to establish a culture of compliance with University policies, and state and federal regulations. The candidate will assist in the development, revision, interpretation and maintenance of University policies and procedures, as well as serve as a key member of the Office of Operational Review in carrying out such other duties as supports its mission. The Associate Director is also responsible for staying current on new developments regarding federal and state regulations affecting public institutions of higher education. The candidate will also be responsible for negotiating, drafting and reviewing contracts. The Associate Director will assist the Director by performing other duties as assigned, including serving in her absence as the senior official in the department.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Required: The ideal candidate is required to have a Juris Doctorate from an ABA accredited law school, and have at least (5) years of experience performing legal work. Preference will be given to candidates with experience in college/university operations, and a working knowledge of higher education laws and applicable regulations. The desired candidate should also possess excellent oral and written communication skills, have the ability to prioritize and manage multiple tasks, meet deadlines, and function both independently and collaboratively as part of a team.

**ENVIRONMENT:** 

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a public research university with High Research Activity. The University has an enrollment of 16,700 students and it employs 1,800 full-time faculty and staff. UL Lafayette consists of 9 degree-granting units: the College of the Arts, B.I. Moody III College of Business Administration, Education, Engineering, General Studies, Graduate School, Liberal Arts, Nursing and Allied Health Professions, and the Ray P.
