POSITION:	Assistant Professor, Science/STEM Education. This position is a nine-month appointment. Summer teaching may be available.
RESPONSIBILITIES:	The applicant will be responsible for teaching undergraduate methods courses in elementary or secondary science and/or graduate courses in an additional STEM area of expertise. Additional duties include: advising students in the College of Education; supervising student teachers; developing & implementing projects associated with the applicant's research agenda; serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees; engaging in scholarly activities and professional activities as deemed necessary by the department, college or university.
QUALIFICATIONS:	Applicants must have earned a terminal degree in Curriculum & Instruction, Science Education, STEM education, or related field. Candidates must have at least three years of classroom experience as a certified teacher. Prior higher education teaching is desirable. In addition, the applicant should have or show potential to produce scholarly publications and fundable projects. Participation in professional organizations such as NSTA and AERA is also desirable. Candidates who are ABD will be considered, but degree must be completed prior to starting date . Preference will be given to applicant's who: 1) demonstrate a robust ability to intersect the sciences with related disciplines; 2) have led or contributed to NCATE/CAEP, NSTA, or ACEI accreditation reports; or 3) have designed or taught courses through hybrid or online delivery.
