ACADEMIC VACANCY

Assistant Professor – Exercise Science (ED 8-14)

- POSITION:** The School of Kinesiology within the College of Education at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette is seeking applications for an Assistant Professor in Exercise Science. This is a nine-month tenure track position with the possibility of summer employment.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The successful candidate selected for this position will be expected to initiate and maintain an active line of research as well as actively pursue internal and external funding to support research and instruction. The candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in one or more of the following areas: Motor Control, Biomechanics, Exercise Physiology, Immunology, and Nutrition. Additional teaching areas and specific assignments (e.g. classes in either a specific area of specialization or supervision of Kinesiology interns) may be required depending on candidate expertise and departmental needs. The candidate will also be expected to advise undergraduate students and serve as chairman/member for Master's student committees. A willingness to collaborate with other faculty and staff within the department, college, university, and community is essential.
- QUALIFICATION:** An earned doctorate in the area of Exercise Physiology or closely related field is required. ABD will be considered; however, the initial appointment will be at the rank of Instructor until requirements for a Doctorate are met. Postdoctoral training is preferable but not required. Previous teaching experience and a background in laboratory methods are expected and national certifications through either the NSCA or ACSM are highly desirable.
- ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:** UL Lafayette is one of eight publicly supported universities in the Louisiana system consisting of nine degree-granting colleges and the Graduate School. The university's enrollment is over 17,000

students and it employs 550 full time faculty. UL Lafayette offers 80 undergraduate degrees, 30 master's degrees, and 10 doctorate degrees. The School of Kinesiology has 20 full time faculty members and over 1,000 undergraduate students. The School of Kinesiology offers a B.S. in either one of the two majors of Athletic Training and Physical Education or one of three separate Kinesiology concentrations in Exercise Science, Sports Management, or Health Promotion and Wellness. The School of Kinesiology offers a M.S. degree in Exercise Science and Health Promotion/Recreation and Sport Management.
