POSITION: Assistant Professor of Educational Leadership, tenure track. (EEO# ED 9-14)

RESPONSIBILITIES: The College of Education at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, Department of Educational Foundations and Leadership, is seeking to fill a tenure-track position at the assistant professor rank. Primary responsibilities include but are not limited to: teaching graduate level coursework in educational leadership; advising students through the master degree program internship/field experience; undergraduate teaching/advising in the university's teacher preparation courses, working with colleagues in program planning and revision; willingness to teach off-campus cohorts; establishing and maintaining an active research agenda; and providing service to the university, college, department, community, and profession.

QUALIFICATIONS: The ideal candidate must have an earned doctorate in Educational Leadership or related field from an accredited institution (ABD candidates with a completion date no later than July 2015 will be considered for this position) and practical experience at the K-12 building and/or district levels in educational leadership. Desirable qualifications include experience in directing and supervising doctoral students; a demonstrated record of research and scholarly publications; teaching experience at the higher education level; skill in online and other alternative delivery systems; ability to work collaboratively with colleagues, and commitment to and experience with diversity issues.

ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT: The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is A PUBLIC Research University with High Research Activity and an enrollment of 18,000 students and 575 full-time faculty members. The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges accredit the University. The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of nine publicly supported universities governed by the University of Louisiana System. It consists of eight undergraduate/graduate degree-granting- colleges, and a graduate school. The College of Education consists of four academic departments in the disciplines of Curriculum and Instruction, Educational Foundations and Leadership, Counselor Education, and Kinesiology.

Our Educational Leadership Program offers an Ed.D. degree in Educational Leadership with concentrations in either K-12 education or higher education. As a precursor the university offers an M.Ed in Educational Leadership. All of the leadership programs are undergoing an exciting period of growth and regeneration. A colleague who is enthusiastic about preparing and training educational leaders for challenges of the new millennium is sought. This person will have the opportunity to assist in enhancing the advanced leadership program while furthering the program's distinctive reputation.

SALARY: Tenure track position with the salary being commensurate with rank, qualifications, and experience.
