| <b>ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:</b> | <p>The Department of Mechanical Engineering is one of five engineering departments in the College of Engineering at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette. The department has a very strong ABET accredited undergraduate program and a growing graduate program. There are currently fourteen mechanical engineering faculty members, with growth expected over the next five to ten years. Annual research expenditures in the department approach one million dollars.</p> <p>The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a public research university with High Research Activity with accreditation from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges. With an enrollment of over 18,000 students and 575 full-time faculty members, UL Lafayette is the largest of nine universities in the University of Louisiana System. The University offers degree programs in 54 undergraduate disciplines, 20 post bachelor certificates, four graduate certificates, the master's degree in 27 disciplines, and the doctorate in 10 disciplines.
