POSITION: Assistant Athletic Trainer

RESPONSIBILITIES: The Assistant Athletic Trainer's responsibilities will include, but are not limited to the following: Assist the Director of Athletic Training in the supervision of the Athletic Training Room; prevention, treatment and reconditioning of athletic injuries; medical and insurance record keeping; inventory; recruitment and supervision of student trainers. Position may include teaching duties. Must be committed to the compliance process and adhere to University, NCAA and Sun Belt Conference rules and regulations.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must have an earned Bachelor's Degree (Master's Degree preferred) from a regionally accredited institution and be currently certified by the National Athletic Trainers' Association. Applicant must also be currently certified as a Louisiana Athletic Trainer (or be eligible for certification). Must have experience in working with both men and women athletes. Experience with college student-athletes preferred.
