- POSITION:** Instructor – Architecture & Civil Engineering
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The position requires teaching of courses within the colleges of engineering and architecture. Primary teaching responsibilities include undergraduate engineering and architectural structural engineering design classes and the instruction of engineering laboratories along with leading the civil engineering senior design project and participation in the architectural design studios
- QUALIFICATIONS:** An M.S. degree in civil engineering with extensive experience in the building construction industry. The individual must have an in-depth knowledge of construction materials, architectural systems and details, engineering principles, mechanical and electrical systems for buildings, construction drawings and specifications. A license as a professional engineer is required.
- ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS:** This is a joint appointment between the Department of Civil Engineering and the School of Architecture with the candidate being formally housed in Civil Engineering.
- Department of Civil Engineering. The civil engineering curriculum at UL Lafayette offers an array of courses in structural engineering and courses that support site development, in general. These include structural courses that support the curriculum of the UL School of Architecture and Design. Joint activities between these two programs are encouraged and prepare the students for careers in the building and construction industry.
- The School of Architecture and Design. Both the bachelor of science in architectural studies and the master of architecture programs are offered. A primary goal of the architecture curriculum is to balance professional and technical education with a liberal arts education.
- The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a Research University with High Research Activity public institution with an enrollment of 18,000 students and with a full-time faculty of 800. UL Lafayette consists of 9 degree-

granting units: the College of the Arts, B.I. Moody III College of Business Administration, Education, Engineering, General Studies, Graduate School, Liberal Arts, Nursing and Allied Health Professions, and the Ray P. Authement College of Sciences. The University offers degree programs in 55 undergraduate disciplines, 20 post bachelor certificates, the master's degree in 28 disciplines, and the doctorate in 10 disciplines.
