POSITION SUMMARY:

The Senior Network Engineer works closely with IT (Information Technology) personnel and Network Services (NS) customers to provide enterprise level, network engineering services that include installing, upgrading, maintaining, and monitoring the University's voice and data communication systems.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Install and maintain local and wide-area, data and voice communication networks including Internet and Extranet connection points.
- Determine methods to implement maintenance, changes, upgrades, and monitoring of the University's data and voice network.
- Be responsible for the reliable operation of the hardware and software elements of the University's data network infrastructure.
- Provide analysis and consultation for all network equipment including wireless and security related appliances and applications, and telecommunications systems and services.
- Oversee the daily operations of last mile networking at all campus locations, including programming and maintaining these systems.
- Assist in the preparation of documentation for decision packages that include the design of complex, institution-wide networking strategies.
- Compile or assist in the compilation of statistical information for special reports.
- Provide support for University technicians and IT personnel in troubleshooting problems relating to the campus-wide data and voice networks.
- Prepare reports and other documents as directed by the NS Network Operations team leader.
- Interface with the University's HelpDesk for problem reporting and resolution.
- Manage efficient workflow and task priorities.
- Supervise student employees assigned to the NS Network Operations team.

- Provide leadership and support for complex network and infrastructure implementation activities which may occur off hours (nights, weekends, holidays, etc.).
- Participate in an "on-call" support rotation when needed.
- Other duties as assigned by NS Network Operations team leader.
