**POSITION: Assistant Research Professor, Research/Clinical Track**

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

This position is expected to contribute to the expanding biomedical research program at the New Iberia Research Center and the University, and participate in the Center's service to clients. The candidate should demonstrate a strong potential for or documented evidence of, extramural funding and strong potential for development into an independent funded researcher. Also, potential for scholarly development at a rate consistent with that of an assistant professor on the tenure-track including a record of peer-reviewed publications in which the individual is a primary author or co-author and participation in relevant academic or professional meetings. Institutional service in the form of clinical care of the Center's animal care is expected at a 10-20% time commitment.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

A Ph.D., and D.V.M. in a relevant field and postdoctoral experience required. Participation in the expansion of biomedical research and educational opportunities across the University in collaboration with academic units such as the Departments of Biology, Kinesiology, Chemical Engineering or Chemistry, is highly desirable. Evidence of, or the potential for, substantial non-didactic teaching and mentoring of postdoctoral fellows, junior research colleagues or students at any level is desired. Upon invitation by the academic department and with consent of NIRC Director, the successful candidate will be strongly encouraged to teach and mentor students in such units as Biology, Kinesiology, Chemical Engineering, Chemistry or others, as appropriate. At the discretion of the department and consistent with their standard operating procedures, academic departments can offer candidates adjunct faculty status in the applicable department, and may enter into discussions of tenure track appointments. Such a tenure track appointment would carry with it the expectation of teaching, research and service applicable to all tenure track faculty members.

**UNIVERSITY AND COMMUNITY:**
