RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate should have expertise and experience in operating systems (OS) with different platforms (Windows, Unix/Linux, Mac), network programming, online data processing, and day-to-day systems maintenance and troubleshooting.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Maintain and develop the three units (CACS, CMPS, INFX) and CMIX websites.
- Design and implement School wide data collection, sharing and distributed storage.
- Install, configure, monitor and maintain Windows, Unix/Linux and Mac-based systems.
- Install and keep up to date software in the School's instructional and research labs.
- Train CMIX students, faculty and staff on using new software when needed.
- Maintain system services and servers, such as DHCP & DNS and LDAP.
